NOTICE AGAINST TRESPASS

This communication shall serve as a notice against trespass. Under New Hampshire law, RSA 635:2A, a person is guilty of trespass, a misdemeanor, if such person,

1. Knowing that he/she is not licensed or privileged to do so, enters or remains in any place or occupied structure; or
2. Knowingly enters or remains in any secured premises; or
3. Knowingly enters and remains in any place in defiance of an order to leave or not to enter which was personally communicated to him/her by the owner or other authorized person; or
4. Knowingly enters and remains in any place in defiance of any court order restraining him/her from entering such place so long as he/she has been properly notified of such order.

This notice shall serve as a communication from said owner or authorized person.
